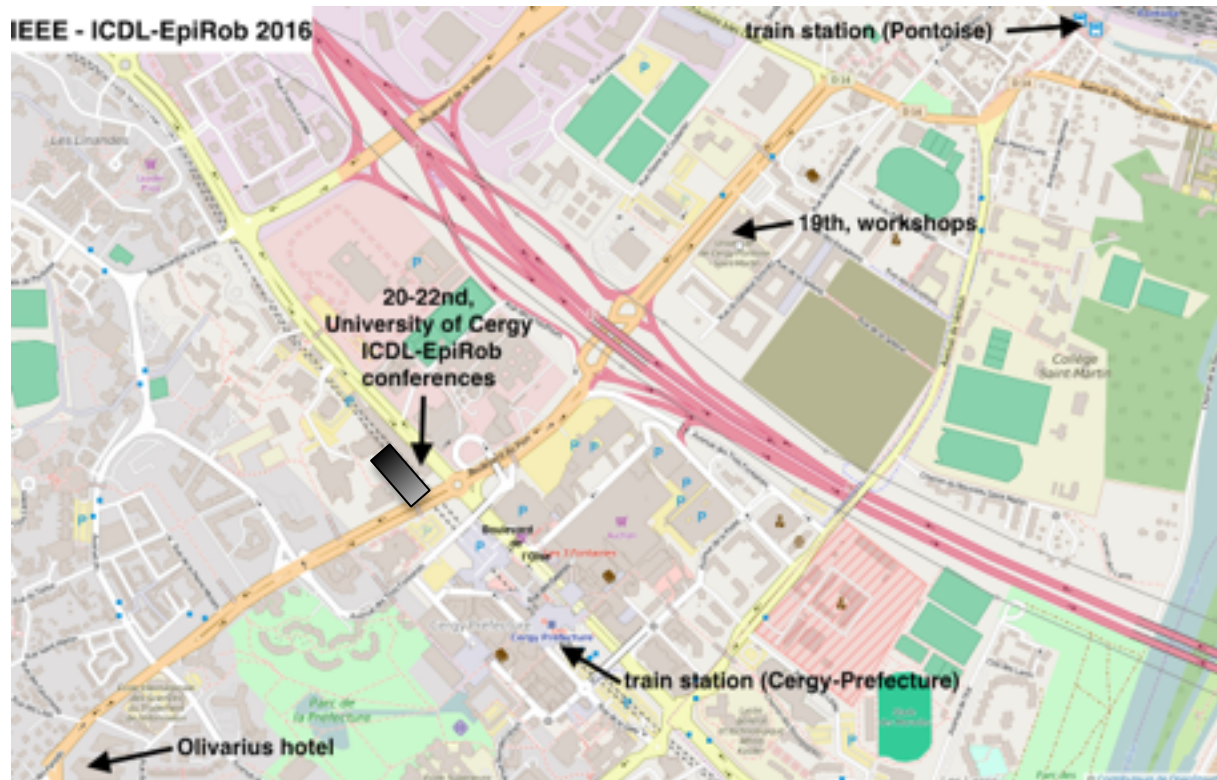


Epirob-ICDL 2016 how-to (minimal survival guide)

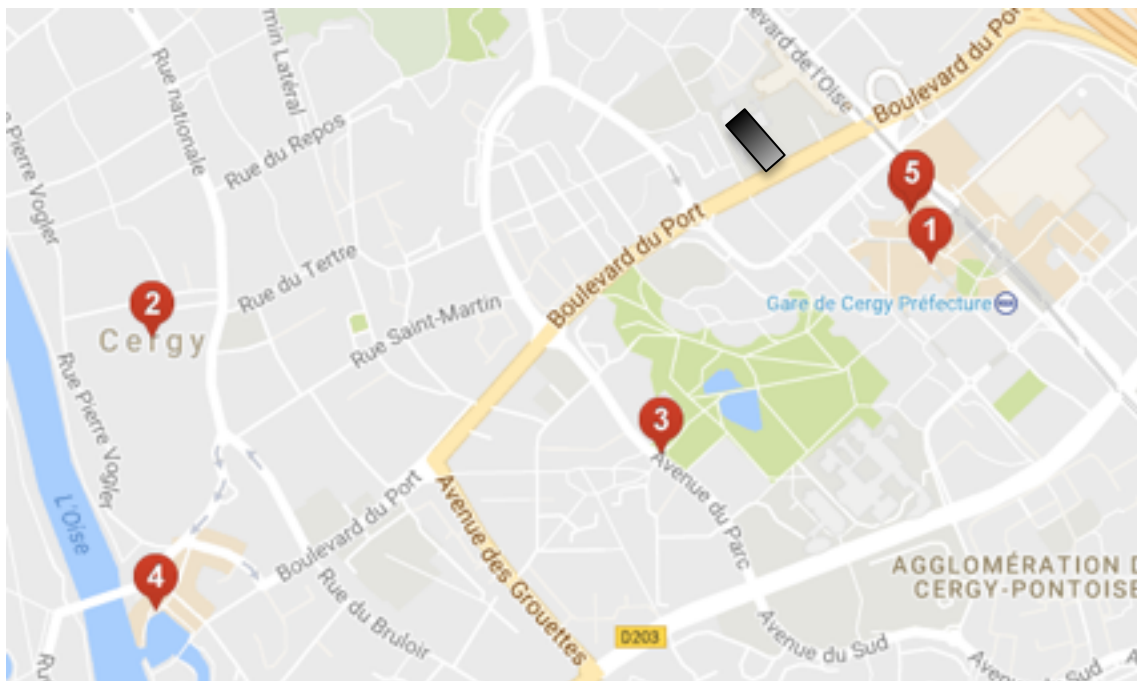

Where to eat at lunch time (Conference) ?

There is an abundant offer of restaurants and fast-foods at 2mn walk from the University. at the « 3 fontaines » mall.

The mall itself is located in front of the university, you will just have to cross the pedestrian bridge in front of the university to start to see restaurants and shops.

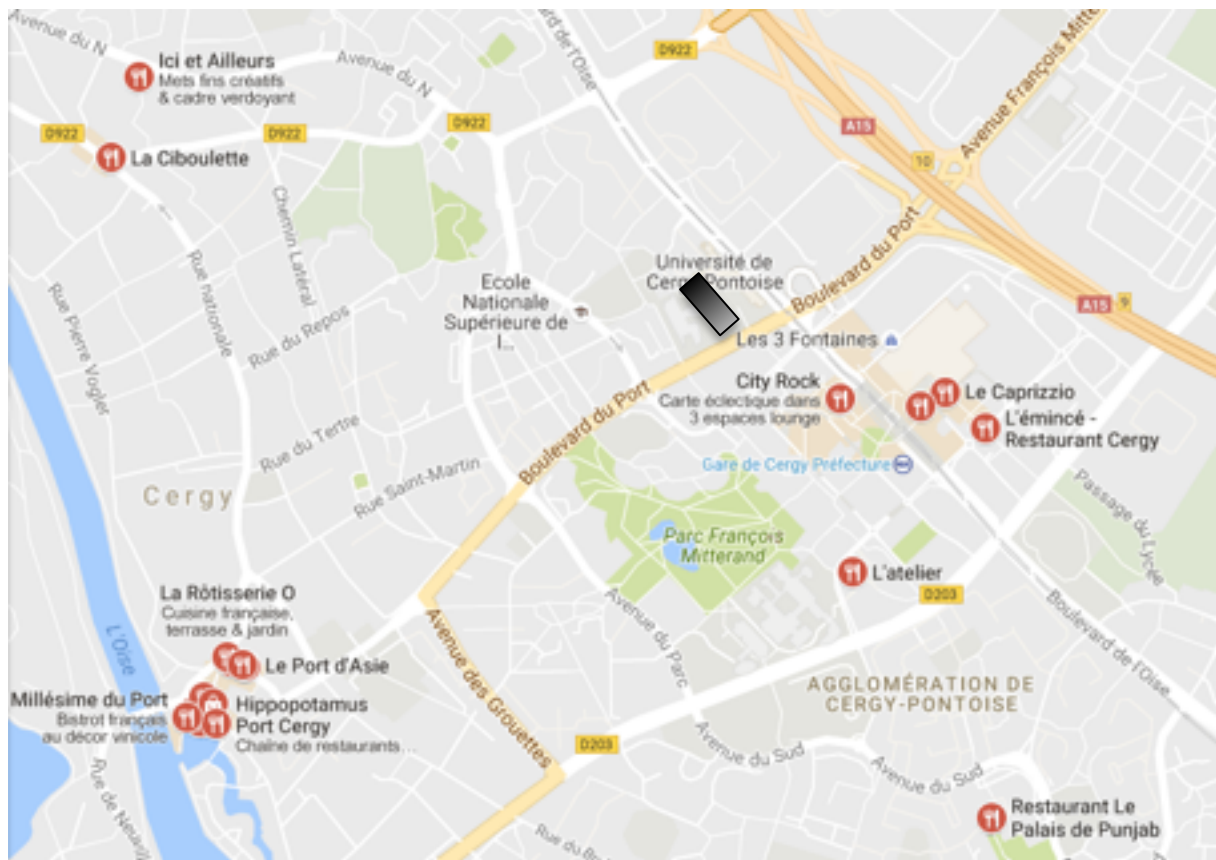

Once again, most of the restaurants are concentrated at the marina « port cergy » (also convenient if your accommodation is at the Olivarius Hotel).
